An Overview


Longing for revival, we catalyze movements that call every corner of every campus to follow Jesus.

We sense God filling our movement with propulsive, holy energy for more of God's transformation on campus. Below is an overview of our Strategic Plan that will guide us for the next four years.

Plant and Grow

With God's help, we'll plant at 350 new campuses by 2022. We want to plant and grow chapters that embody our core essential attributes: biblical, collegiate, diverse, holistic, and missional. We believe the Lord can use us, in partnership with others, to bring a powerful movement of the Spirit among a new generation of students and faculty. Revival is absolutely the work of the Lord, and we can prepare the soil on campus and in our own hearts to facilitate what he wants to do.

In our initial test of 22 campuses, the number of graduating seniors who started giving to InterVarsity increased from 12% to 40%!

WE WILL REST


We will intentionally prioritize Sabbath rest at all levels, from senior leadership to campus staff.
