## Teaching Plan

Time	Who	Task	Transition
Pre-course	Small Group Leaders	Receive a clean copy of the 2 Peter manuscript. Print a paper copy. Save a copy to your desk-top on your computer.	
	Small Group Leaders	Attend the gathering in Tim's zoom room to go over the teaching plan and practice zoom hosting skills	
	Small Group Leaders	Make sure you have and can open the google doc we'll be using. Here is a link to it: <a href="https://docs.google.com/document/d/1VKITwLCW-g665M2WHuBqXbJywb1wrlH167QFYRXM7kE/edit">https://docs.google.com/document/d/1VKITwLCW-g665M2WHuBqXbJywb1wrlH167QFYRXM7kE/edit</a>	
	Small Group Leaders	Look over the list of people in your small group. These are the people who will show up in your break out room. Maybe think ahead about who can be an assistant for you (someone who is familiar with google-docs).	
<b>Bible Study – Thurs, July 16 1:40 – 2:00pm</b>			
2 mins	Leon	Introduce the bible study, open with prayer, hint at the theme/direction (why this text).	
2 mins	Leon	A first-read through with everyone online. Leon shares screen showing the whole group the Google Doc. (could pick a leader, or read it yourself)	Heading to small groups, Brian w. instructions
1 min	Brian	Transition people to break out rooms.	

<b>7 min</b>	Small Group Leaders in chat rooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Greet everyone in your group.</li> <li>-Share-screen and show your group the PDF of the manuscript (NOT THE GOOGLE-DOC). Have the first paragraph of the manuscript visible on the screen you are sharing.</li> <li>-Find a scribe in your small group who can open the google-doc on their computer/device and type in comments as the group shares observations. Have the scribe put the verse number behind the comment.</li> <li>-Encourage people to share verbally and visually. Verbally is ok – the scribe can put their observation in the google doc even if they can't figure out how to annotate the shared screen.</li> <li>-Find the annotate tool on your screen and turn it on. Start marking stuff. Encourage others to mark things as they notice them. Encourage the scribe to type into the google-doc observations people are annotating on the screen.</li> </ul>	Skills: 1 Screen sharing 2 Annotating 3 Google-doc
	Brian	After 7 minutes, send the chat rooms a note to move on to the second paragraph.	
<b>7 min</b>	Small Group Leaders	Transition to the second paragraph. Stop annotating – close the annotate tool bar. Move the manuscript up on your screen so that the second paragraph is visible. Start annotating again – open the annotation tool bar. Observations on paragraph 2 (caption, manuscript, Google-doc).	
	Brian	Sends everyone the signal that the break out rooms are closing. Wrap up comments.	
<b>3 min</b>	Leon	1- Welcome everyone back. 2-Affirm the great work in observations you saw (give a shout-out to the best paragraph titles you saw). 3-One of the groups with Notability can screen-share their manuscript with the whole group (60 seconds) 4-Leon can recap the very best one or two observations from each paragraph.	Brian sends people back into small groups. Small group leaders will explain what's happening.
<b>7 min</b>	Small Group Leaders in chat rooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Welcome your group back</li> <li>-This time SCREEN SHARE THE GOOGLE-DOC and not the PDF of the manuscript.</li> <li>-The text will be at the top of google-doc</li> <li>-The interpretation questions will be below that in a table.</li> <li>-Discuss only the question you have been assigned.</li> <li>-You'll be able to scroll up if you need to see the text. You'll be able to scroll down if you need to consult your observations.</li> </ul>	

		-With at least 3 minutes left, transition to writing your answer(s) in the table in the google-doc. -Another group will also be answering the same question. Don't worry about what they say -your group's answer will be better anyway 😊	
	Brian	4 minutes into this section, send the chat rooms a note to fill in the google chart.	Bring people back to the main room.
3 min	Leon	"So what does Peter want us to understand?" Welcome everyone back. Leon will pick one of the small group leaders to share per question. Just go in order of the groups (Groups 1 & 2, Groups 3&4, Groups 5&6, 7&8).	
8 min	Leon	Application – stay together as a whole group. Leon can summarize and do a little preaching. He can also send people as a whole group back to the google-doc with ONE CLEAR APPLICATION question.
